




- Announced by Secretary of State Hillary Clinton in April 2010 as part of the Presidential Summit on Entrepreneurship
- Directed by Department of State's Global Entrepreneurship Program
- Managed by ImagineNations Network



E-Mentor Corps Purpose


- To provide mentors & support to entrepreneurs
- To strengthen connections between entrepreneurs in America & other nations
- To advance entrepreneurship, innovation, & economic opportunities


ImagineNations Network

- Entrepreneurs matched with mentors online
- Online meeting place for young entrepreneurs, Ementors, NGOs, supporters, financial institutions, commercial outlets, etc.
- Developed in partnership with Cisco & The World's Bank Global Partnership for Youth Investment

How It Works

- Mentees & Mentors create "Entrepreneur" or "Supporter" profiles
- 2. Mentees find Mentors by:
 - Sending a Mentor Request specifying their objectives, type of mentor expertise sought, location, etc.
 - Searching Mentor database & submitting Mentor Request to specific mentors
- 3. Mentors find Mentees by searching through open Mentor Requests
- 4. Both Mentor & Mentee must accept a mentoring offer

Post multiple Mentor Requests if you have business needs that require very different areas of business expertise (for example, setting up an accounting system and developing a marketing plan).
